6. Rock Ridge Run Report - Lydia

- a. Fun Facts
 - 287 students registered which is 69% of school (2019 = 365/77%)
 - 216 students received pledges which is 52% of school (2019 = 303/64%)
 - Parents gave the most with 33.2% with \$8752 and then grandparents made up 33% with \$8688
 - Received pledges from 42 states and 3 countries (US, United Kingdom, Australia)
 - Ran 12,590 laps which is 393 miles ~ Castle Rock to Moab
- b. Rock Ridge Run Funds
 - Pledged \$26,324.75
 - Collected \$26,294.75 which is a 99.9% collection
 - Profit minus 10% paid out to Boosterthon for FUNRUN.COM \$23,665.75 (2019 \$30.346)
 - Mrs. Breithart's class raised the most with \$2,433 and won Rocco the Eagle
 - Mr. Rasavage's class came second with \$2,109
